Officiating Horizontal Jumps

Before the Competition

- Inspect landing area and runways
- Confirm what help, if any, you will have
 - Minimum: 1 raker, 1 marker
 - Ideal: 2 rakers, 1 marker, 1 tape puller
- Review responsibilities with your helpers



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Before the Competition (continued)

- Check in Competitors
 - Remind them that NO RUNBACKS are allowed
 - Record which take-off board they will use
 - Inform the competitors what may be used for check marks along the runway (Games Committee/host school determines what material may be used)
 - Maximum number: 2
 - Must not be on the runway
 - Communicate information about how the event will be run
 - Ask if any competitor will have to check-out for another event
 - Inform them that they may take attempts consecutively or out of order before they leave (preliminaries and/or finals)



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During the Competition

- Measure properly
 - Read at the board edge closest to the pit
 - Lesser 1/4-in or cm
- “Close” the runway between jumps
 - Stand in the middle of the runway until the pit is raked and cleared before calling the next competitor up
- Follow tie-breaking procedure if needed
- If preliminaries and finals are held, the finals are conducted from worst to best



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After the Competition

- Close the event area – NO MORE PRACTICING
- Confirm the results are accurate
 - Make sure tie-breaking procedures have been used if needed
- Hand in results to appropriate personnel
- Return any equipment (tapes, clipboards, cones, etc.)

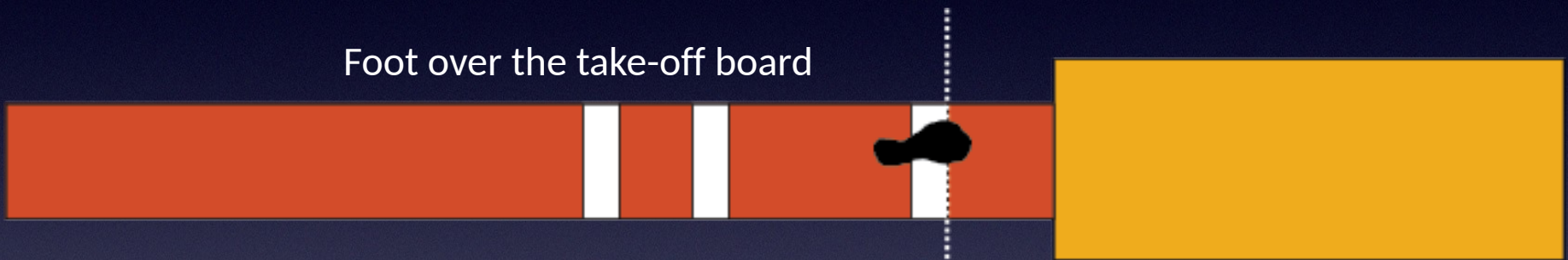


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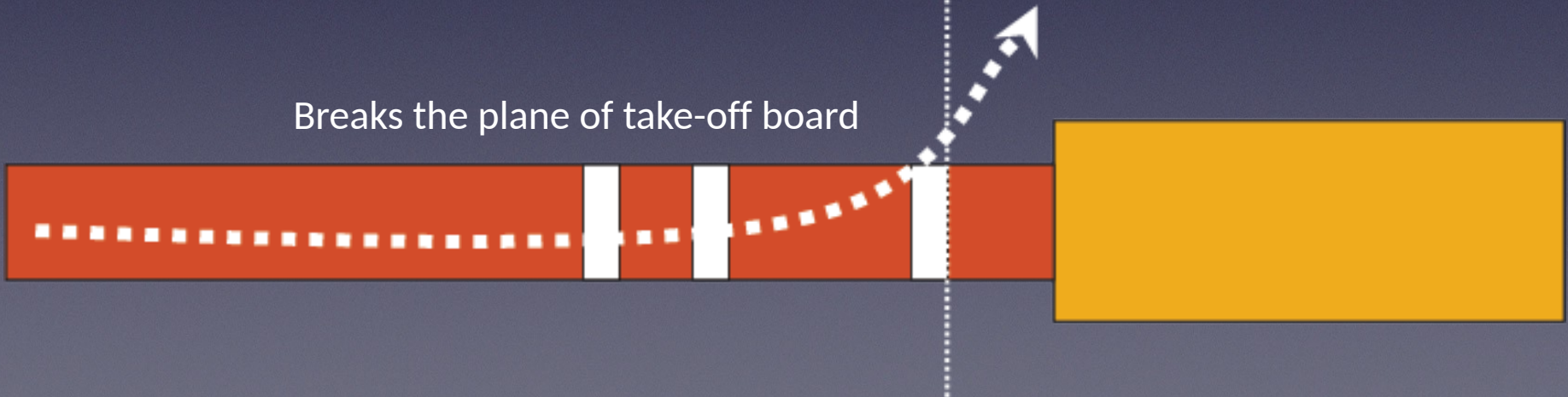
Fouls

Foul Line

Foot over the take-off board



Breaks the plane of take-off board



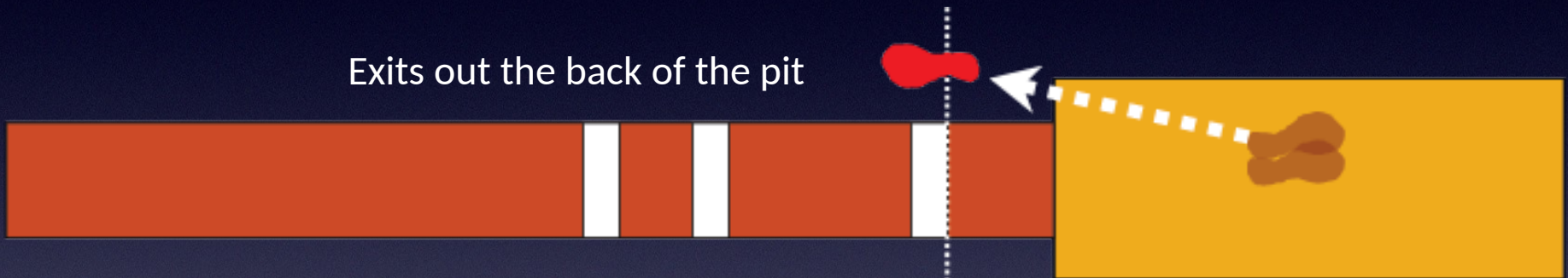


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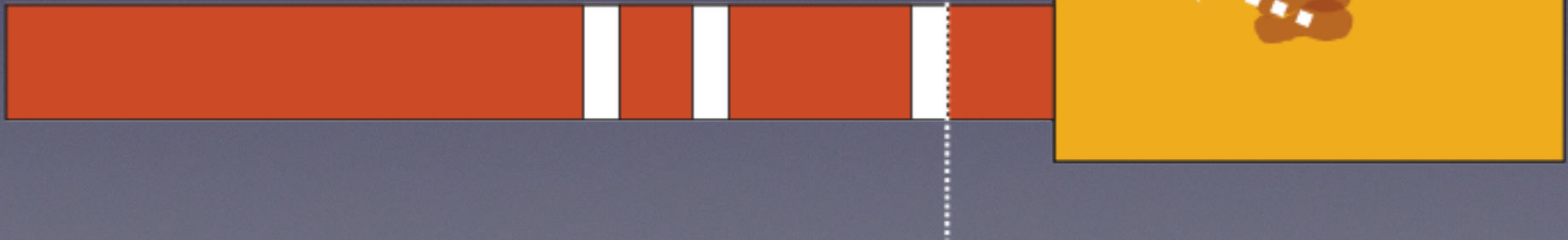
Fouls

Foul Line

Exits out the back of the pit



In the process of landing or leaving the pit, touches the ground outside the landing area and closer to the found line than their man in the pit





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Fouls

- Failure to initiate the trial within time limit
- In the triple jump
 - In hoping (1st phase), does not land on the same foot used in take off
 - In stepping (2nd phase), does not land on the opposite foot of the hop



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
